OUR NIGHTLY SCHEDULE

24/7 Ministries Trek and Journey meet on Wednesday evenings from 6:30-8:00pm. Check-in time between 6:25 and 6:30.

Puggles, Cubbies, Sparks, and T&T clubs meet on Sunday evenings at 5:15 pm. Club starts with check in time between 5:15 and 5:20. Everyone will be on his or her color line for flag ceremony by 5:20.

Note: Puggles and Cubbies go directly to their room to begin. The other clubbers will meet in the fellowship hall for check in time and flag ceremony.

Our club night is broken down into three segments. We use a 5-count in some segments to get started. The director/leader who is in charge may begin to count aloud, slowly to 5, when the clubbers here this count begin, they should immediately be quiet and give their full attention to the one in charge.

DESCRIPTION OF CLUB SEGMENTS

There are 3 different segments for each club. Each segment runs approximately 30 minutes.

GAME TIME is the fun time for all clubbers. They participate in games just for their age level for fun, to develop good sportsmanship, and to encourage clubbers to work as a team.

HANDBOOK TIME is when the clubber recites the sections they have learned to their leaders and for leaders to challenge the clubbers to accept Christ and grow spiritually.

COUNCIL TIME is the most important time in which we present the gospel to the clubbers.

After the Flag Ceremony, which is how we bring the club to order to begin the night, the clubs will split up as follows.

CLUB RULES

1. You must respect, cooperate with and obey your leaders and other staff members.
2. You must take part in the entire club program unless you brought a note from your parents or you are excused by your club director.
3. You must walk to and in all rooms, concrete areas and parking lot except at game time when instructed by the games coach.
4. You must remain with your leader at all times during club.
5. You must remain in the church building at all times. If you need to leave early your club director must know when you leave.
6. You are to remain with your leaders until your parents come to the room to get you. It is our desire that no clubbers are at risk of being injured in the parking lot. **PARENTS** For their safety, **you** must come to the designated area to pick up your child.
7. For safety reasons we cannot permit sandals, flip flops, boots, jellies, crocs, or heelys. You must have Tennis shoes to play the games.
8. If you disobey the rules we will enforce our one-two-three count.
The one-count: a warning that you are disobeying one of the rules.
The two-count: you must go to your club director for a talk.
The three-count: Your parents will be called immediately to talk to the commander and you may be sent home. You may not return to club unless parents have assured that you will behave.

AWANA STORE

The AWANA store is a great place to learn about responsibility. You earn shares so that you may purchase items in the store. Check schedule for dates when the AWANA store will be open.
